Hands-on implant placement & restoration course, with ongoing mentor support

Dental implants are a treatment of choice to replace missing teeth. And the general dentist with proper training is more than capable of handling straightforward implant placement and restoration.

This program is designed for the general dentist who is already comfortable with both extractions and crown & bridge, and wants to add simple implant placement and restoration to the services they offer. More than a basic familiarization, this program is an intensive and extensive tutorial - as part of the training you will learn case selection, technique, place and restore implants on models, treatment plan and place an implant into your patient under supervision at our facility, and learn marketing and other important skills. You are also welcome to visit our centre at your convenience outside of course hours, to view further live surgeries and other treatment.

Now in our twenty-third year, it is interesting to compare today's course to back when we started. The course has changed dramatically, partly because we continually adjust it based on student feedback, but also because implant dentistry is changing so quickly. Our teaching centre is located in the same building as our practice, and is purpose-built to allow us to provide this kind of learning experience.

While our course continues to change, our goal remains the same: to present the information in a fun, collegial way, and to eliminate the stress of learning a new treatment.

When you complete this course, you should be able to place and restore single root form implants in straightforward cases outside of the aesthetic zone.

Most importantly, we and our staff are committed to providing you and your staff with ongoing support after the course has ended and you proceed with cases on your own. We are always just a phone call or email away. The importance of this support cannot be overstated.

Cost
